**ADULT GRADUATION POLICY**  
**For**  
**PENELAKUT ISLAND LEARNING CENTRE**



## **Preamble**

Adult students may enrol at Penelakut Island Learning Centre in order to obtain an Adult Dogwood Diploma. Penelakut Island encourages non-graduated adult students to pursue education and remains committed to providing this opportunity. The main goal is to have non-graduated adult students become self-sufficient through education.

## **Program - Adult Dogwood Diploma**

Students completing an Adult Dogwood Diploma are not required to write Provincial Exams. However, students planning to attend a post-secondary institution should consult with that facility to determine if a provincial exam mark is required for admittance.

This graduation program has been designed for adults over the age of 19 to reach a level of education identical to secondary school graduation. Adult students must meet graduation requirements as set out in the *Handbook of Procedures for the Graduation Program 2013-2014*.

## **Administrative Procedures**

1. Registration for adults occur prior to September of the upcoming school year and prior to 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of the current school year.
2. Adult students must provide registration information and sign for release of previous school records.
3. Penelakut Island Learning Centre must report credits earned by students to the Ministry for entry on student transcripts for calculation of graduation eligibility
